# **Commercial Reward and Recognition Scheme**

#### Milestone Payments

Inventor(s)/discoverer(s) of a new invention will be rewarded for participation in the Intellectual Property commercialisation life cycle in accordance with the following:

- Invention Disclosure \$350
- Provisional Patent Application Filling \$2,500
- International PCT Patent Application \$7,500

## Q-Accelerator & Development of Technologies and Targets (DOTT)

Access to internal funding initiatives, Q-Accelerator and DOTT, designed to provide guidance and financial support while accelerating projects toward achieving commercial value.

#### **Salary Awards**

In the event of successful commercialisation of any invention/discovery, with the long-term viability of the project being confirmed and reviewed regularly by the Business Development team, the following awards will be applied:

Net Commercialisation Revenue*	Salary Award
In excess of \$1.5 million	One year
In excess of \$5 million	Two years
In excess of \$10 million	Three years
In excess of \$20 million	Five years
In excess of \$50 million	Seven years

\$150,000 per annum will be added to the Q-Accelerator program budget for each year of salary support awarded in accordance with salary awards. Inventors who receive salary by award will be able to apply to Q-Accelerator to access these funds for ongoing commercially-driven research in their labs, with the quality and strategic fit of the proposed research program assessed via the regular Q-Accelerator process.

In addition, \$50,000 will be made available to the inventor receiving the salary support to prepare such an application to Q-Accelerator.
